



## Explanation of the 5-Level Alert System

Please prepare yourself for what to do in the event of a disaster by checking in the chart below the proper actions to take for each level.

Alert Level	Action(s) to Take	Broadcasted Information	
		Evacuation Info (Announced by Nagasaki City)	Weather, Climate & Earthquake Info (Presented by Japan Meteorological Agency)
Level 5 Alert	Take the most suitable action (s) to protect your life.	Info about the occurrence of the natural disaster	Heavy Rain Emergency Warning
Level 4 Alert	Evacuate as soon as possible to your designated evacuation shelter or a place that you have determined as safe.	Evacuation Order (Urgent) Evacuation Advisory	Landslide Warning Info
Level 3 Alert	Begin evacuating people who require more time to evacuate (elderly people, disabled people, infants, etc.) All others should begin preparing for evacuation.	Evacuation Preparation/Start of Evacuation of the Elderly, etc.	Heavy Rain Warning/ Flood Warning
Level 2 Alert	Go over what you will do when evacuating.		Heavy Rain Advisory/ Flood Advisory
Level 1 Alert	Mentally prepare yourself for the disaster.		Early Warning Info

Note: The evacuation information that will be announced by Nagasaki City is determined based on various information. It will not always be the case where the same warning level announcements will be made by both parties at the same time.
