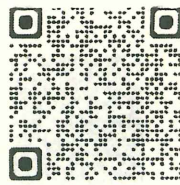

Use the QR Code to the right if there is anything you are unsure of, such as garbage station locations or collection days.

Put garbage out by 8am in designated garbage bags. Please cut down on garbage and separate by type.

Write collection days for your area. You may dispose of up to 3 bags per garbage type per collection day.

Collection Days
Twice a week

1 Burnable Garbage

Kitchen Waste
Drain first!
● Drain off liquid.
● Wrap in paper.

Used Oil
Use paper or cloth to absorb oil.

Clothes / Blankets / Small Bedding etc. Cotton Products

Disposable Diapers etc. Sanitary Products
Flush human waste down the toilet.

Wood / Bamboo
Bundle wood up to 1m in length and 40cm in diameter.

Plastic Products
● Plastic String
● Toothbrushes
● Buckets
● Hangers
● Clear Files
● CDs / DVDs / Video Tapes / Cassette Tapes etc.
● Remove metal parts.

Rubber and Leather Products
● Remove metal parts.

Collection Days
Once a week

Old Paper

Bundle with string according to type.

Newspapers / Flyers

Books / Magazines / Paper Cartons / Miscellaneous paper (paper boxes, paper bags, wrapping paper, etc.)

● Sandwich miscellaneous paper larger than a business card, such as paper boxes, paper bags, and wrapping paper, between books and magazines.
*Starting May 2018, you can also put this paper out in a paper bag tied it shut with string or a colorless, clear plastic bag.
● Photographs, carbon paper, and receipts are "Burnable Garbage."
● Open out paper cartons and rinse and dry them before disposal.

Collection Days
Once a week

5 Non-Burnable Garbage

Spray Cans / Gas Cartridges
Empty out the contents/gas. Do not punch a hole into the container. Only put the spray can or gas cartridge in the non-burnable garbage bag.

Metal
(other than saucepans, pots, kettles, and pans)

Lighters
Empty and pierce

Razors / Pins and other sharp objects

Glass
(other than bottles)

Ceramics

Broken Fluorescent Tubes

Wrap in newspaper or similar and mark designated bag with "WARNING EDGED TOOL" or "WARNING BREAKABLES".

Home Medical Supplies (non-sharp)
Do not throw away hypodermic needles or other sharp objects.

Special Manufactured Bottles (disinfectant bottles etc.)
Drink bottles and makeup bottles are "Recyclable Garbage".

Small Electrical Appliances
● Vacuum Cleaners ● Toasters
● VCRs ● Radios
● Rice Cookers (the inner bowl is "Recyclable Garbage")
● Electric Fans ● Irons ● Printers etc.

Others
● Umbrellas
● Light Bulbs
● Incandescent Light Bulb
● LED Bulbs
Items that will not fit in bags, such as long umbrellas, may be left sticking out at the top of the bag (items longer than 1m must be disposed of as "Oversized Garbage").

Please Note
Make sure to empty out the contents/gas from any spray cans and gas cartridges and not to punch holes into them.
When emptying out the contents/gas, please do so outside in an area with good ventilation so there is no risk of fire.
On non-burnable garbage pickup days, separate spray cans and gas cartridges from all other non-burnable garbage into another bag.

8 Fluorescent Tubes

Collected on the same day as "Non-Burnable Garbage".

Put into the fluorescent tube container or next to the battery bucket in its original packaging. Put broken tubes in "Non-Burnable Garbage".

*Put incandescent light bulbs and LED light bulbs in "Non-Burnable Garbage".

6 Plastic Packaging

*Please separate correctly as garbage will be recycled after collection.
*Plastic containers and wrapping which are thrown away immediately after consuming contents.

Food Trays / Egg Cartons

Tubes
Should be placed in "Burnable Garbage" when contents cannot be disposed of.

Snack Packets / Rice Bags

Yoghurt / Dessert Containers

Wrapping

Styrofoam
Break up large items.

Shock-Absorbing Packaging (for fruit)

Shampoo Bottles etc. / Detergent Containers
Remove caps and nozzles.

Blister Packs (for capsule medicine etc.)

Lids from PET bottles

Plastic Oil Bottles

Plastic Bags
Make sure that the bags are empty.

Labels from PET Bottles

Please Note
1 Separate Correctly
Look for the Plastic Recycling mark.
2 Clean Items
Rinse dirty items and wipe dry.
3 Do Not Double-Wrap Items
Do not wrap items in plastic bags before putting them in the designated garbage bag.

7 Recyclable Garbage

Empty Cans
● Juice Cans ● Beer Cans
● Food Cans ● Snack Tins
● Oil Cans ● Seaweed Tins
● Can Lids (metal)

Empty Bottles
● Juice Bottles ● Oil Bottles
● Condiment Bottles
● Alcohol Bottles
● Health Drink Bottles
● Medicine Bottles
● Makeup Bottles
● Bottle Lids (metal) etc.

Metal Pans / Pots / Kettles / Frying Pans

PET Bottles
Remove lids and labels

● Mineral Water Bottles
● Soy Sauce Bottles
● Alcohol Bottles
● Mirin Bottles
● Soy Sauce Product Bottles (soup stock etc.)
● Seasoning Bottles etc.

Please Note
1 Rinse thoroughly.
2 Put plastic lids in "Plastic Packaging". Remove metal lids and put in "Recyclable Garbage".
3 Leave plastic fittings around the necks of bottles if they are difficult to detach.
4 Containers that have been re-used around the home to hold medicine or paint cannot be recycled. Please put plastic bottles out as Burnable Garbage, and cans and other bottles out as "Non-Burnable Garbage".

Any Time

9 Cylindrical and Button Type Batteries

There are battery buckets located at garbage stations. You may not put rechargeable batteries in the battery buckets.

Please do not put trash other than batteries in the buckets. Please be sure to isolate button type batteries by wrapping them in tape.

10 Oversized Garbage

Advance application necessary.
Applications: Mon - Fri, 08:00 - 16:15
*Clean Nagasaki is closed when national holidays fall on a weekday.

Fee Applies

Charge per item
★ Up to 1m in length / under 30kg in weight = ¥ 523
★ Between 1m-2m in length / 30-60kg in weight = ¥ 1,047
*Purchase a sticker from a financial institution (bank / post office etc.).
*We will come to collect the items from your door.
*Items over 2m in length or 60kg in weight cannot be collected.
Please take such items to a processing plant yourself, or arrange collection through a private company.

Computers Please contact the manufacturer and arrange a collection. You can also dispose of them as "Oversized Garbage" by applying with one of the companies listed to the left.

*The mouse and keyboard included at the time of purchase can be collected with the computer. Printers and other external devices must be disposed of separately.
*You may also contact the PC3R Promotion Association (TEL 03-5282-7685) to arrange collection if the manufacturer is no longer in business, or if you built your own computer.

On-site Collection of Spray Cans, Gas Cartridges, and Lighters

In the case that you have spray cans/gas cartridges whose contents/gas have not been emptied out, or in the case that you do not have enough spray cans/gas cartridges to fill up a whole bag, there is on-site trash collection at every regional office and environmental center, and the Waste Management Division where you can drop spray cans and gas cartridges off. We also collect used lighters.

Garbage Not Collected by the City

- **Industrial Waste** As defined by law, 20 types of waste produced by industrial activities are not dealt with by the city.
→ Please contact a private waste disposal company.
- **Difficult-to-dispose-of Items** Fire extinguishers / agricultural chemicals / infectious medical waste (eg. hypodermic needles) / cans containing oil or paint / batteries / motorbikes / tires / cylinders / button batteries etc.
→ Please return these items to the point of purchase, or contact a private waste disposal company.
- **Large Quantities of Waste** Large amounts of waste produced in one go, eg. when moving house, cannot be collected. Please take this waste to a processing plant yourself, or contact a private waste disposal company.
→ You must purchase a ticket to take your trash directly to the processing plant. Purchase a ticket from City Hall, an administration center, or a branch office.
- **4 Types of Home Appliances** Washing machines and clothes dryers / LCD, plasma, and CRT televisions / refrigerators and freezers / air conditioning units (Home Appliance Recycling Law applies).
→ Please consult with the original point of purchase, or the shop where you will purchase a replacement.
