
## 1 When will it start?

**Put Both in the Yellow Designated Bags!**


No change to pickup days. You can continue to use current yellow designated bags.

# 4 Rules for Disposal

Please observe the below rules when throwing your plastic garbage out.

◎ Empty the contents of all containers



◎ Rinse clean



◎ Tie the bag shut



◎ No double bags



# 5 Prohibited Items



Do **NOT** throw away the below items into the yellow bags as it may harm workers or cause fires.




◎ Rechargeable batteries

(such as lithium-ion batteries for portable chargers)



• Bring to a designated collection point.

Attention: Some devices such as portable fans and wireless earphones use rechargeable batteries. Bring these items to a designated collection point.

◎ Small home appliances



• Bring to a designated collection point.

◎ Lighters and spray cans



• Empty contents and put in a designated non-burnable garbage bag.

• Bring to a designated collection point if you cannot finish all contents.

\*Do not pierce any holes

◎ Kitchen knives and scissors



◎ Medical devices such as syringes.



• Wrap in paper and put in a designated non-burnable bag.  
\*Write a warning on the bag such as "Danger! Knives(はものきけん)."

• IV sets (except fluid packs), needles, syringes, etc.  
• Ask your medical institution about disposal methods
