Guide to Sort Garbage

- Put garbage out on the collection day by 8 AM in designated garbage bags
- Please reduce and properly sort your garbage
- You may dispose up to three bags of garbage per type. Items that do not fully fit into a garbage bag are oversized garbage

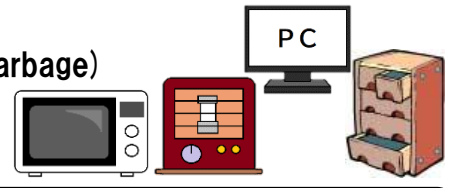

How to sort garbage Nagasaki City

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Collection Day	Garbage Type	Main Objects
毎週 曜日	燃やせるごみ Burnable Garbage	●Kitchen Waste (Drain out all water and wrap in paper) ●Rubber, Leather, and Fabrics (Dispose of old clothes at a designated collection point) ●Paper Scraps (Photographs, carbon paper, receipts. Do not dispose of recyclable paper here) ●Wood and Plants (Sticks must be within 1m in length and in bundles of less than 40cm wide) 
毎週 曜日	Recyclable Paper ※Collected on the first collection day of the week	●Newspapers and Flyers ●Books and Paper Cartons (Open paper cartons, rinse, and dry before disposal) ●Miscellaneous Paper (Can be disposed of in paper or clear plastic bags) ●Cardboard ※Bundle with string according to type 
毎週 曜日	Non-burnable Garbage	●Metal (Dispose of saucepans, pots, kettles, and frypans with Recyclable Garbage) ●Glass and Ceramics (Wrap broken objects in newspaper, etc.) ●Home Appliances ※Dispose of small home appliances at a recyclables collection point (For objects that fit in the 25cm×10cm opening to the collection box) ※Empty spray cans before disposal. Dispose of only the can, without puncturing any holes 
	Plastic Garbage ※You may continue using previous designated bags	●Containers and Packaging with the Plastic Recycling Mark ●Bottles, Caps, and Labels ●Styrofoam and Packing Materials ●Plastic objects (Buckets, hangers, toothbrushes, etc.) ※Dispose of items over 50cm in length (such as plastic string, video tape, etc.) or items over 5mm thick (cutting boards, etc.) with Burnable Garbage 
	Recyclable Garbage	●Empty bottles and cans (Drinks, food, cosmetics) ●PET Bottles (Dispose of the cap and label with Plastic Garbage) ●Metal saucepans, pots, kettles, and frypans 
	Fluorescent Tubes	●Fluorescent Tubes (Dispose in your garbage station' s fluorescent tube container) (Dispose of LEDs, incandescent light bulbs, and broken fluorescent tubes with Non-burnable Garbage) 
Any Time	Disposable Cylindrical Dry Batteries	●Disposable Cylindrical Dry Batteries (Deplete button cell batteries and dispose of in your garbage station' s battery container) ※Dispose of rechargeable batteries at a designated collection point 
	Oversized Garbage Fee applies	●Objects that do not fully fit in designated garbage bags (Umbrellas under 1m in length may be disposed of with Non-burnable Garbage) ●Dangerous items (such as kerosene heaters with built in ignition devices) ●Microwaves, Safes, Sewing Machines, and Computers ※Apply for collection over the phone or deliver yourself to the processing plant ※Apply for collection over the phone: 095-801-2200 (Hours are Monday-Friday (Except Holidays) 8:00 AM ~ 4:15 PM) 

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Items not collected by Nagasaki City

Items designated by law/regulation and items that are difficult to dispose of

- 4 Types of Home Appliances (①Washing machines and Clothes dryers②Televisions ③Refrigerators and Freezers④Air conditioners)
- Special Waste (Fire extinguishers, agricultural chemicals, car/motorcycle batteries, tires, etc.)
- Large Quantities of Garbage (Garbage from moving, etc.)
- Industrial Waste (The 20 designated items by law from offices or shops)

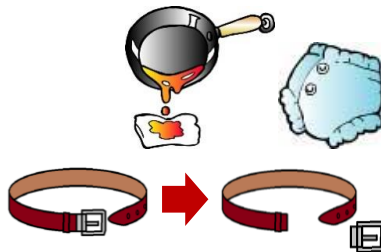


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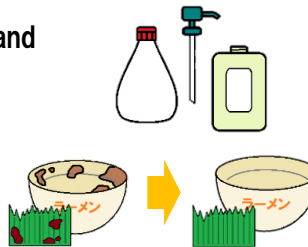
Burnable Garbage

- Cooking oil
⇒ Solidify oil or soak into paper/cloth
- Disposable diapers/Sanitary products
⇒ Flush human waste down the toilet
- Remove any metal pieces from objects



Plastic Garbage

- Use all contents
⇒ Soak any unused contents into paper/cloth and put in **Burnable Garbage**
- Clean items
⇒ Rinse dirty items with water
- Do not double-bag
⇒ This will hinder the separation process at the waste processing plant



● Do not dispose of any of the following in garbage bags:

Mobile batteries, Lithium-ion/rechargeable batteries,
Rechargeable small household electronics

⇒ This could cause fires in the collection trucks or
at the processing plant. Dispose at a designated collection point.



Oversized Garbage

Fee applies

- Take to the processing plant yourself
- Apply for pickup over the phone
⇒ To apply for pickup :

※ Maximum of two items per pickup application
※ Rate per item (As of April 1st, 2026)
• For items up to 1 meter in length and under 30kg.....¥730
• For items between 1-2 meters in length and 30-60 kg.....¥1,460

On-site Collection of Recyclables

※ Limited to household items

- Old fabrics (Clothes, kimonos etc.)
⇒ Collected at Regional Offices (other than Mie, Nameshi, and Takashima), etc. (Free)
• Will not accept exceptionally dirt items, socks, stockings, underwear, or carpets.
(Put in burnable garbage)
- Small home appliances
⇒ Collected at Regional Offices
(other than Mie, Nameshi, and Takashima), etc. (Free)
• Only items that fit in the collection box (25×10 cm)
• Delete any personal information in advance
• Remove all batteries before inserting into the collection box
• Items cannot be retrieved once inserted into the collection box
• Do not put any rechargeable batteries, such as mobile batteries, or other batteries in the collection box
- Rechargeable batteries (Mobile batteries, lithium-ion batteries, etc.)
⇒ Collected at City Hall and some Regional Offices (Free)
※ Including bloated/expanded batteries
- Mercury thermometers/Mercury blood pressure monitors
⇒ Collected at City Hall and
Regional Offices (Free)
- Spray cans, gas cartridges, and lighters
⇒ Unemptied containers collected
at City Hall, Regional Offices,
and Environment Centers (Free)

Animal Remains

- ¥620 per animal for pet dogs and cats (As of April 1st, 2026)
Collection of the remains of stray dogs/cats is free
⇒ Contact your area's collection company for requests

Non-burnable Garbage

- Spray cans, gas cartridges
⇒ Empty contents before disposal. Dispose only
the can or cartridge, without puncturing any holes
- Blades, broken glass and ceramics, etc.
⇒ Wrap in newspaper or other paper and write a warning, such as
“Danger, blades! (はもの きけん)” or
“Danger, broken! (われもの きけん)”
- Medical waste from home treatment
⇒ Consult with your medical institution for proper disposal



Recyclable Garbage

- Rinse thoroughly
- Plastic lids go with **Plastic Garbage**
Metal lids go with **Recyclable Garbage** (separate from container first)
- Leave plastic fittings around the neck of bottles if they are difficult to detach
- Items that cannot be cleaned, cut/ altered items, or items that held paint or medicine
⇒ Dispose bottles and cans with **Non-burnable Garbage**,
and PET Bottles with **Burnable Garbage**

Delivering Garbage Yourself

Fee applies

- If you are looking to dispose of oversized garbage/a high volume of garbage, etc., you can deliver garbage yourself directly to the processing plant
⇒ You will need to acquire a “Self-delivery Ticket” in advance
※ Self-delivery Tickets are available at Regional Offices or through the Resource Recycling Division at City Hall
(Distribution hours: Monday-Friday (Except Holidays) 8:45AM ~ 5:30PM)

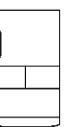
Items not collected in Nagasaki City

- Difficult to Dispose of Items
(Including fire extinguishers, pesticides, infectious medical waste
(such as syringes), oil and paints, bicycles, motorcycles, tires,
batteries (car/motorcycle), cylinders, items marked as Class I
Specified Products (such as humidifiers and water servers), etc.)
⇒ Please consult with the store you bought these items from or with a
private waste disposal company
- Large volumes of garbage
⇒ Please either deliver yourself to a processing plant,
or request pickup from a permitted municipal waste collection
and transport service contractor
- Industrial waste
⇒ Reach out to a private waste disposal company
